**Re: Atlas Air Crew Member Quarantine Exemption Effective 25 August 2020**

"Pursuant to Section V of the 12th Emergency Proclamation related to the COVID-19 Emergency the following exemption is issued:

- Flight crew on a trans-pacific flight arriving into the state due to, or for, work purposes may leave their designated quarantine area only for:
  - a. Outdoor exercise, excluding ocean activities, so long as physical distancing requirements are met; and
  - b. Picking up food for consumption at their designated quarantine location.
- Flight crew on trans-pacific or inter-island flights returning to their county or island of residence after a work trip are not subject to the traveler quarantine.

Crew will need to provide their credentials only in order to avail themselves of this exemption.

This exemption supersedes any county policies with respect to airlines crews, interisland flights, and interisland quarantine. All other county and state proclamations and orders remain in force.

**Violation of any of the above by any flight crew will result in the exemption being rescinded for all personnel who work for the airline involved."**

Ford/Exemption Team,

I am sending this email in an attempt to clear up any confusion from the previous supplemental order. Ford also please share with the airlines as you see fit.

"Pursuant to Section V of the 12th Emergency Proclamation related to the COVID-19 Emergency the following exemption is issued:

\* Flight crew on a trans-pacific flight arriving into the state due to, or for, work purposes may leave their designated quarantine area only for:

- a. Outdoor exercise, excluding ocean activities, so long as physical distancing requirements are met; and
- b. Picking up food for consumption at their designated quarantine location.

\* Flight crew on trans-pacific or inter-island flights returning to their county or island of residence after a work trip are not subject to the traveler quarantine.

Crew will need to provide their credentials only in order to avail themselves of this exemption.
