- Probation Period

- ❑ Ends One Year from Date of Hire
- ❑ Turn to the Union FIRST for any issues, LARGE or small
- ❑ You are entitled to and WILL get the MAXIMUM Protection the Union can provide, even while you are on Probationary Status!
- ❑ All Contractual methods still apply to first year members
- ❑ Don't worry about "being on the radar" This is why we're here.
- ❑ Roughly ¼ of the FO list is on probation.

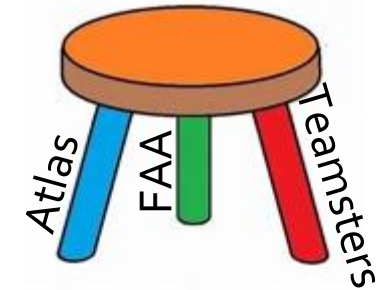

 - ❑ Can occupy empty cabin seats as well

Contract Highlights

Can't do a full view but we can hit some high notes

Gateway, Deadhead, and Alternate Travel

- ❑ Gateway Airport Selection
 - ❑ Company automatically assigns nearest commercial airport in the Gateway Airport List
 - ❑ Pilot can select from any airport in the Gateway Airport List

- ❑ Travel to/from Gateway Airport and Base considered gateway travel
 - ❑ All other travel considered alternate travel
 - ❑ Do Not Confuse with Deadhead, Alternate Travel

Pay

- ❑ Training Pay
 - ❑ \$1,600 per month until completion of OE or 4 months (whichever occurs first).
 - ❑ \$2.75/hour per-diem (~ \$2,000 per month while in MIA).
 - ❑ Big Check, Little Check
 - ❑ 1/2 Min Guarantee, then 1/2 min Guarantee PLUS last months overages
 - ❑ Coming off Training pay
 - ❑ After OE signoff or 4 months. NO Additional pay on OE for days off!
